3rd - Randy Kvapil is beginning to like Pat Mayse. He qualified for the Central Regional he just competed at via the BASS Nation NE

Region Championship on Pat Mayse last fall. Randy weighed in a solid 18.18 lbs. bag. I didn't ask Randy how he caught his fish, so you can all assume it was a fluke. He is the Fluke Master after all.

4th - Mike Hughs sacked up a limit of wind-blown keepers. Mike flipped up his 16.88 lbs.

5th - Jason Wise makes what I believe is his first trip into the top 5. If I am wrong Jason, I apologize. Congrats on a nice bag. Jason had 5 for 15.98 lbs. caught on flukes I understand.

6th - Russell Roland, The Champ is Here. He asked me to say that. He wins a tournament this year and it went straight to his head. Russell had 4 fish strong enough to edge out 6 bags that had limits behind him. Russell caught his throwing a Brush hog and even had a top water fish.
