Pat Mayse has been high and muddy for more than a month. As the lake levels have been falling, the fishing has been super tough. The weekly rains and cold fronts have compounded the issue. Spring is here though and Dan was able to find that shallow bite.

1st - Dan had the only limit of the day, with 5 that weighed 16.31 lbs. Dan started the morning with a jig and then switched to a Senko after the jig quit producing. Dan focused on areas that had reeds and buck brush together.

2nd - David Porter had 4 that went 13.38 lbs. David caught his on split shot flukes in 2-3 ft of water around bladed grass.

3rd - Denis Canuel had 4 fish. He caught a good one that weighed 6.57 lbs and his total catch for the day was 12.94. Denis caught his fish on a red trap and flipping watermelon red baby brush hogs near bladed grass.

4th - Derick Maschmeier had 4 also. His fish weighed 11.27 lbs.

5th - Dakota Jones had 4 fish that weighed 10.20 lbs. Dakota caught his flipping a Strike King Structure Bug to the thickest brush.

6th - Keith Green rounds out the top 6 with 1 good fish that weighed 8.91.

Big Bass - Keith Green's 8.91 took big bass honors. Keith's fish barely held on to the top spot by 2 hundredths of a pound as Richie Slack weighed a 8.89 lb beauty.
