1st - George had a really nice bag of fish for such a tough day. He had 1 of the 2 limits in this tournament. George had 15.77 lbs. He caught his fish in a number of ways. Mostly on a shaky head trick worm.

2nd - Chad Petrie had five keepers on this tough day also. His fish weighed a respectable 11.45 lbs. They were fooled with a frog, senkos in the bushes, and under docks. He caught his last keeper at 2:45pm to secure 2nd place.

3rd - Mike Casanova had what he called 2 "lucky" bites. I would argue that if you go bit at all on that day, you were lucky. The good thing about his 2 fish is that they were good ones. They weighed 8.06 lbs.

He had one early on topwater, and one on a shaky head in the late afternoon.

4th - Bert Petrie followed Chad in the standings with 4 fish. He was the only angler to catch 4 fish. So he had a pretty good day also. Bert's 4 weighed 8.16 lbs. He caught his fish on C-rigs around brush and senkos on the retaining walls.

5th - Dan Phifer caught his 3 fish on shaky head around docks. His three went 7.42 lbs.

6th - Jim Linderer rounded out the top 6 with 2 that weighed 7.27 lbs. He wasn't available for comment at the time this newsletter was written. So I am not sure how he caught them, but I'm sure he was happy to have them.
