1st - Randy Kvapil was able to put a nice 5 fish limit together, weighing 16.36 lbs. Randy fished grass with a fluke in 3-7' of water. Randy marked his return to the club by winning the 2nd tournament of the year. We are glad to have him back fishing with us.

2nd - Bill Cox put the same pattern together that Randy did, with a fluke around grass, and also brought a nice 15.36 lbs. limit together. As tournament director, Bill puts a lot of work into these tournaments on tournament day and before. Thanks and congrats Bill.

3rd - Randy Conover was right there with the other two leaders. Randy had 5 for 15.13. He did it a little different than the other two. Randy caught his fish flipping reeds. Others found this

pattern, but Randy was able to find the bigger fish and get them in the boat.

4th - Jason Wise had a nice showing with 4 fish that went 13.79. Quality fish for sure. Jason fished with Randy Kvapil and also caught his fish on flukes. Great job Jason, 1 more and you would have been contending for the lead.

5th - Mike Hughs had a limit also, weighing 11.41 lbs. Mike caught most of his fish flipping, but did have one keeper deep on a hard head.

6th - Coy Frazier rounded out the top six with his 11.20 lbs. limit. Coy's fish were caught flipping a brush hog, with one also coming on a centipede.

Big Bass - Randy Kvapil had big fish for the tournament with a 6.23 lbs. lunker.

Heavy Boat - Randy Kvapil and Jason Wise took heavy boat honors with 30.15 lbs.
