As we all know, when the power plant is running, fishing is really good, but when they turn it off, it gets pretty tough. That was the scenario that Century Bass encountered at Brandy Branch over the weekend of February 16/17. Someone usually figures out the bite and this event Coy Frazier figured out the deep bite and put together a good bag under less than optimal conditions.

1st - Coy Frazier had 5 that weighed 15.81 lbs. Coy caught his fish in 20 - 30-foot-deep on Carolina and Texas rigged soft plastics.

2nd - Phillip Webb had 5 that weighed 14.16 lbs. fishing from Coy's boat. Dragging soft plastics tricked his 2nd place finish.

3rd - Jon Harshbarger weighed in a limit weighing 12.31 lbs. Jon targeted spawning flats with wacky rigged trick worms.

4th - Mike Rice caught 4 fish anchored by the big bass of the day for 11.96 lbs. Mike caught his fish shallow on a wacky rigged Senko.

5th - Exploiting the shallow bite, Randy Kvapil weighed a 5 fish limit weighing 10.46 lbs. on a chicken sh*t rig.

Big Bass - Mike Rice's 4th place bag was anchored with this weekend's big bass. The 5.01 was caught about 10 foot deep on a wacky rigged Senko.

Heavy Boat - Frazier/Webb ran away with heavy boat combining for 29.97 lbs.
