3rd - Philip Webb had another strong finish with 5 weighing 15.24 lbs and 2nd big bass at 5.95#. These fish fell to a white chatterbait.

4th - Richie Slack's limit was also caught on the white chatterbait on the warm water side. Richie weighed in 14.02 lbs.

5th - Thomas Anderson caught 4 fish weighing in at 10.47 lbs.
