



George opens the season on Squaw Creek with 16.88 pounds

A smaller tournament field started the 2019 season as the flu and unseasonably cold weather kept the numbers down. After the northerly 25-35 winds laid down Century Bass took on Squaw Creek.

1st - George Bryan had the best bag on the day at 16.88# which included 2nd big bass at 5.32#. His fish were caught on spinnerbaits and soft plastics in 3-10 foot of water. He was able to cull up twice.

2nd - Mark Alexander brought in 4 fish for 13.30# with the day's big bass of 5.34#. Mark did his work on dropshot 8-10 foot deep, and reported missing several opportunities to fill out his limit.

3rd - Bruce Maschmeier rotated though several offshore presentations to weigh in a limit that went 13.11#. Seven keepers fell to c-rigs, dropshots and a jig in 10-15 foot of water.

Heavy Boat - Randy Kvapil and Mike Rice took the award with 19.30 pounds winning by 0.06#.
