



## Chad Finds Hot Bite on Brandy Branch

For a change, the plant kept running over the weekend and fishing was good, if you were on the hot side. When the fog cleared, six anglers were able to locate limits with Chad running away with the first tournament of the 6<sup>th</sup> decade in the storied history of Century Bass.

1<sup>st</sup> - Chad Petrie had 5 that weighed 19.09 lbs. Chad caught his fish on a rig in the morning and senkos in the afternoon, culling up several times.

2<sup>nd</sup> - Mike Aziz had 5 that weighed 14.39 lbs with 2<sup>nd</sup> big bass at 5.08. Mike caught his fish on senkos and flukes on the hot water side around shallow cover.

3<sup>rd</sup> - Jon Harshbarger had another of the 6 hot water limits. Jon's 5 weighed 12.87 lbs. The fish came shallow on flukes and senkos.

4<sup>th</sup> - Philip Webb's caught fish all day 4-6' deep on senkos and flukes as well. His limit settled on the scales at 12.46 lbs

5<sup>th</sup> - Randy Kvapil caught his limit on flukes and senkos fish on squarebills. These 5 weighed in at 11.70 lbs.

6<sup>th</sup> - Coy Frazier had the final limit of the day for 10.29 lbs. Coy bucked the shallow trend spending his day out deep dragging soft plastic.

Big Bass - Chad Petrie's big bass fell for a rig and weighed in at 5.49 lbs.

Heavy Boat - Phillip Webb/Mike Aziz had heavy boat with 26.85 lbs.
