We had an early start on Ray Hubbard to beat the heat. I think the heat still got to us. It was definitely a tough day on the water, with only 4 limits caught out of the 33 person field. There were some nice fish caught though. We weighed at least 9 fish that went over 5 lbs.

1st - Dan Phifer was able to put a good stringer together. Dan had 21.72 lbs. He caught them on a shakey head or a Texas rigged worm around rocks in 10-15' of water.

2nd - Randy Kvapil had a good bag weighing 17.24 lbs. Randy was 1 fish short of a limit, so with a 5th fish, he would have really had a good bag. Randy caught 1 on a fluke and 3 on a shakey head trick worm on a drop from 13 to 20'.

3rd - Chad Petrie takes 3rd for the 2nd tournament in a row. Chad's fish weighed 13.51 lbs. Chad caught his fish drop shotting a fluke in 15-20'.

4th - Mike Casanova caught his fish around rip rap in 4-10' with a jig or a shakey head. Mike's bag of 5 weighed 13.47 lbs.

5th - Mike Hughs mixed it up catching fish early on a buzzbait, then finessing docks, then throwing a c-rig deeper. Mike had 4 for 12.16lbs

6th - Jon Harshbarger rounds out the top 6 with 3 for 12.12 lbs. Jon caught his on a 10" blue fleck power work around rocks.

Big Bass - Randy Kvapil had an 8.08 lbs. beauty to take big bass honors.

Heavy Boat - Dan Phifer and Zach Yates combined for heavy boat with 7 that weighed 27.02lbs.
