Big Sam returned to normal lake level on Saturday after being above normal pool for 8 months. How would the always changing conditions impact the fishing.

- 1st In first place was Bert Petrie who rode a Saturday 5 fish limit of 20.50 lbs. to the win with 26.59 lbs. Dan Phifer had 5 that weighed 11.36 lbs. Bert caught his fish shallow generally around vegetation on t-rigged plastics both days.
- $2^{nd}$  Todd Guernsey missed his  $3^{rd}$  win of the season by 0.59 lbs. with 10 fish for 26.00 lbs. Todd bucked the shallow trend and caught both limits on soft plastic in 20 foot of water.
- $3^{rd}$  Dan Phifer weighed in two limits for 24.04 lbs. Dan found the fish hanging around trees and buck brush, and caught them flipping senkos.

4<sup>th</sup> - Randy Kvapil continued with the strong shallow bite with 9 keepers for 22.52 lbs. Randy utilized split shot flukes, shakey heads, frogs and a 3XD pending on the cover to catch his weight.

5<sup>th</sup> - Richie Slack stayed in the shallows to weigh 9 for 22.33 lbs. Richie's fish were all caught on Texas rigged senkos.

<u>Big Bass</u> - Saturday's big bass of 8.61 was caught on a senko by Bert Petrie in shallow cover. A senko flipped shallow fooled a 7.32 lb. bass for Richie Slack which was Sunday's big bass.
