5th - David Porter brought a limit to the scale also. David's 13.69 lbs. Carolina rigging brush hogs and t-rigged senkos around brush and docks.

6th - Ed Shay had a 13.16 lbs. limit. Ed caught his fish flipping a watermelon red trick worm on 5'+ deep docks on the lower end of the lake.
