



Guernsey wins his 2nd in 2019 at Cedar Creek

Cedar Creek was generous with 10 limits the day before Father's Day. The almost weekly rain kept the lake levels high and dirty, resulting in a good number of biting post spawn bass. Todd Guernsey caught one of the plentiful limits including one large bite to take his 2nd win of the year.

1st - Todd Guernsey had 5 that weighed 14.60 lbs. Dan caught his early fish by shallowing cranking and later in the day on plastics in deep brush.

2nd - Philip Webb came close to his 2nd win of the year with 5 that weighed 14.30 lbs. He caught his fish in less than 3 foot of water around rocks and docks on Texas rigged speed craws.

3rd - Jon Harshbarger caught another of the 5 fish limits that weighed 14.15 lbs. Jon caught them during the morning on spinnerbaits in the shore grass and in the afternoon on docks on Texas rigged speed craws.

4th - Dan Phifer continued the shallow water catch by flipping up a 12.12 lb. limit. These bass were located on docks and fell for senkos.

Big Bass - Todd Guernsey's big bass at 6.15 lbs. provided the 0.30 lb. difference to win this event.

Heavy Boat - Guernsey/McDowell had the heavy boat with 16.52 lbs.
