In March we visited the great Toledo Bend. Many of us wish we were closer to this fish factory. We had tough, ever changing conditions; from flooding to dropping water, sunny to storming, windy to calm. We saw it all this weekend. But Toledo bend still showed up pretty strong. Of the 3 tournaments this year, we had fewer people fishing this tournament but more fish were caught and more total weight was brought to the scales than our other two stops.

1<sup>st</sup> - Randy Kvpil scored his second victory in a row weighing limits each day and anchoring his 2<sup>nd</sup> day bag with a 10.24 lbs. hog. Randy repeated his win by repeating his winning bait. He once again put it on us with a fluke. Randy's two day total was 32.38 lbs. Great job Randy.

2<sup>nd</sup> - Chad Petrie also had limits each day and had a nice 7.82lbs. fish on day two to secure his 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish. Chad's two day total was 28.96 lbs. Chad caught his fish flipping in shallow water.

3<sup>rd</sup> - Mike Hughs struggled a bit on Day 1 bringing only two fish to the scale but he kept his head down and went out on day 2 and bagged 18.66 lbs., for the second largest bag of the day. Mike finished the two day event with 23.51 lbs. Mike caught his fish flipping also.

4<sup>th</sup> - Coy Frazier Carolina rigged his way into 4<sup>th</sup> with 8 fish total weighing 21.99 lbs.

5<sup>th</sup> - Dan Phifer rounded out the top five with two limits weighing 21.44 lbs total. Dan caught his fish flipping Cypress trees and throwing a Senko.

Big Bass - Randy Kvapil had big fish for the 2<sup>nd</sup> tournament in a row with a 10.24 lbs. lunker. Richie Slack had the Day 1 big bass with 6.45.
