1st - Chad Petrie had a good bag on Saturday with 18.29 and then followed that up with 12.38 on Sunday to seal the victory. Chad had 10 that totaled 30.67lbs.

2nd - Randy Kvapil had 5 on Saturday that weighed 13.83 and then he went out Sunday and improved on that with a 15.32. Randy's best 10 weighed 29.15 lbs. Randy caught his around cypress trees with a split shot fluke.

3rd - Mark Calhoun had an impressive 4 fish stringer on Saturday for 15.15 lbs. and had another 4 on Sunday that went 10.88 lbs. Mark totaled 26.03. Mark caught his fish Saturday on a swimbait and C-rig on a rocky point. Sunday, Mark had to move shallow since his deep fish wouldn't cooperate and caught them on split shot fluke around shallow cover.

4th - Todd Guernsey had a nice 5 fish limit on Saturday weighing 15.68. Sunday was a little tougher for him. He weighed 4 that weighed 7.99 lbs. His 9 totalled 23.67. Todd caught his fish flippin to the trunk of Cypress trees.

5th - Jason Geesey put back to back limits together to total 22.62 lbs. Jason caught his on square bills and using flukes around Cypress Trees.

6th - Jon Harshbarger had 9 fish for 19.60 lbs. Jon caught his fish on a C-Rig and Flippin.
