



Philip Webb Rocks on Ray Hubbard

Ray Hubbard was about as tough as it gets for the Century Bass anglers. The spring migration stalled midweek with lows in the 30s and for the most part, the bass had not made it to the shallows and were staged in 6-10 foot of water on rip-rap banks. Philip Webb, fresh off his 2nd place finish at Brandy Branch, ran the table taking 1st place, Big Bass and Heavy Boat on this challenging day.

1st - Philip Webb had 3 that weighed in at 13.37 lbs. Dan found these fish on a small swimbait rigged on a $\frac{1}{4}$ head on rip-rap in 6 foot of water.

2nd - Randy Kvapil used a shaky head trick worm on 6-10 foot drops around marinas to weigh in 4 that weighed 7.08 lbs.

3rd - Dan Reudi weighed in 3 weighing 6.25 lbs. Dan utilized a shaky head to trick 2 of his bag and caught the last on a crankbait. These fish were located on the Hwy 30 rip-rap in 6-10 foot.

4th - Mark Alexander was able to coax 2 keepers from the dead vegetation that weighed 6.02 lbs. Pulling a Carolina rig and punching the matted vegetation accounted for his weight

Big Bass - Philip Webb landed a beautiful 6.82 lb. bass that was fooled by his swimbait.
