2nd - Jeff Lugar culled up to a limit that weighed 13.24 lbs. Jeff used a chartreuse and white jackhammer around bushes, wood and secondary points to catch his limit. Jeff culled up throwing a shakey head on the front side of docks.

3rd - Jon Harshbarger stayed on his 2020 roll weighing in a limit going 11.08 lbs. Jon used various soft plastics including senkos, brush hogs and lizards in the shallow cover.

4th - Coy Frazier demonstrated his angling range, abandoning his usual deep haunts to flip up a 4th place limit weighing 11.01 lbs. Coy utilized a black/blue rage bug to amass his weight.

Big Bass - Jeff Lugar dropped a beautiful 5.10 lbs. on the scales to take the Big Bass award. She fell for a green pumpkin Z Man Fatty Z presented on a shaky head off the front of a dock.
