



MASCHMEIER IN LIMELIGHT AT LIMESTONE

On an unexpectedly windy day, Limestone produced more limits and more fish than our last tournament at Pat Mayse. That is a compliment because Pat Mayse was a good tournament also. With 4 limits between 15.74 and 16.92 lbs., Limestone was a nail biter, for eventual winner Bruce Maschmeier.

1st - Bruce Maschmeier topped the group with 5 weighing 16.92. Bruce caught his fish on a C-Rigged Magnum Trick Worm in red bug. There was definitely a shallow bite, but Bruce figured them out a little deeper, and it really paid off.

2nd - Randy Kvpil continues to be hot. He is proving to be a force to be reckoned with. After a 3rd last month he brings in 5 for 16.17 lbs. for a 2nd place finish here. I would expect nothing less from Fluke Master P. He caught his fish on a split shot fluke shallow around reeds.

3rd - Jon Harshbarger who is a perennial favorite for Angler of the Year is making another run this year. Jon had 15.98 lbs. caught flipping shallow willows.

4th - Coy Frazier also figured out a little deeper bite and brought 15.74 lbs. to the scale. Coy also used a Carolina Rig, like Bruce, and tipped his with a junebug Baby Brushhog

5th - Mike Casanova brought in a limit for 13.10. I didn't get a chance to talk to him after weigh in, but I believe he caught his fish shallow and around docks.

6th - Dan Phifer rounds out the top 6 with a limit weighing 12.92. He caught his fish around docks and rip rap with a senko, speed craw and a crankbait.
