



Bruce Maschmeier repeats on Limestone

Limestone produced some good fish and decent stringers this weekend. Half the field had limits and much of the other half struggled. Bruce Maschmeier overcame any obstacles he may have had to take the win for the second consecutive year on Lake Limestone.

1st - Bruce Maschmeier ended the day with 20.81 lbs. and big bass for the day. Bruce caught his fish doing a little of everything. He caught some on topwater, then went to flipping docks. Later in the day he moved to an offshore hump and upgraded. He was able to upgrade 6 times through the day to get to his final stringer.

2nd - Richie Slack is settling in to his new boat nicely. He committed to an area and fished it all day. He was able to fool 18.63 lbs. of bass with his Carolina rig.

3rd - Coy Frazier knew what needed to be done and continued his hot streak with a C-rigged trick worm in 6-10 ft of water. Coy's best 5 went 18.44.

4th - Derick Maschmeier proves to be a consistent threat as he comes in 4th for the second tournament in a row. Derick's caught 16.83 lbs throwing a squarebill and flipping around rocks and docks.

5th - Jason Geesey had a nice bag weighing 15.91lbs. Jason stuck with a square bill or a 5XD to get to his final weight.

6th - Jon Harshbarger rounds out the top 6 with 14.78 lbs. Jon caught his mostly flipping docks.

Big Bass - Bruce's big bag was anchored with a big fish weighing 6.32lbs.
