Lake Tawakoni was tough once again. That summer to fall transition is in progress and the fish are still tough to catch. Dan Phifer was able to manage a limit with one decent fish to take his 4th win of the year.

1st - Dan Phifer had 5 that weighed 11.36 lbs. Dan caught his fish on a Texas rigged speed craw or a Senko in the flooded grass and bushes.

2nd - Paul Zukosky had 4 that weighed 10.25 lbs. He just needed that 5th fish to get his second win in a row. Paul caught his fish on a Norman crankbait in chart/blue back.

3rd - Mike Casanova had another of the 3 limits that day. Mike's 5 weighed 9.99 lbs. Mike caught them on chatterbaits and Texas rigged Senkos in the brush. He also caught a few around a docks on a square bill.

4th - Nick Carroccio had the final limit of the tournament. Nick caught his 5 cranking schooling fish and shakey heads in flooded brush. Nick's limit weighed 9.01 lbs.

5th - Bert Petrie caught his 3 fish on squarebills. Those 3 weighed in at 8.55 lbs.

6th - Ed Shay also had 3. Ed's fish weighed 7.90 lbs and were caught on green pumpkin craws in the flooded dead bushes off the bank and in willows.

Big Bass - The most significant big bass we have had in almost 10 years was the one Chad Petrie caught. His fish weighed exactly 5.0 lbs. That is significant because with started a 5 lbs even pot in January of 2009. So for 10 seasons, this pot has grown and grown. Congrats Chad.

Heavy Boat - Carroccio/Casanova had the heavy boat with 19.00 lbs even.
