1st - Paul Zukosky had a great limit of fish weighing 16.66lbs. His margin of victory was exactly 3 lbs over the next competitor. Paul caught his fish shallow early with a big Wave or Berkley worm. He then moved to docks and finished his limit and upgraded multiple times.

2nd - Chad Petrie had a good bag also with 5 that went 13.66 lbs. Chad caught his fish shallow in the bushes and on deeper rocks later in the day.

3rd - Randy Kvapil was right there with only 4 fish. His 4 went 12.79 lbs. Randy caught his fish on a split shot fluke in the pads.

4th - Denis Canuel had a 5 fish limit weighing 12.20 lbs. Dennis caught his on a Baby Brush Hog in Wat/Red and a chrome/black trap.

5th - Mike Casanova continues to perform well from the back of the boat. Mike had a limit weighing 11.84 lbs. Mike caught his on rocky points with shakey heads.

6th - Todd Guernsey rounds out the top 6. Todd had 5 for 9.95 lbs.

Big Bass - Mike Mrva had a 6.88 lbs big girl to take Big Bass.

Heavy Boat - Chad Petrie and Mike Mrva combined for the Heavy Boat award with 23.53 lbs.
